

Position: Senior Quality Assurance Representative – Wellington, FL

Senior QA Representatives perform general QA services which shall include construction inspection of dams, levees, embankments, berms and dikes; construction of all ancillary features such as flood control gates; surveillance of QA and QC materials testing activities to include collection and laboratory analysis of soil, concrete and water samples; inspection of other general construction; inspection of temporary construction facilities such as road barricades, temporary electrical services, etc.; inspection of other general construction; evaluation and analysis of records associated with construction activities.

- Inspects QC and safety plans to ensure compliance with contract specifications and applicable regulations
- Inspects all phases of a variety of goods, services, or operation for conformity
- Communicates deficiencies to proper officials
- Maintains QA files and documents results of all inspections
- Reviews construction plans and specifications and construction submittals as they pertain to quality assurance
- Except for cost estimates, evaluates construction contractor proposals and other documents for procedures and provides written analysis as it pertains to quality assurance
- Documents inspections via daily reports and enters into government electronic databases, such as RMS
- Responsible for daily site visits to the project site
- Conduct independent follow-up quality assurance inspections
- Maintain deficiency list in RMS
- Review and update submittal register
- Participate in 3-phase inspection control meetings
- Discuss issues/corrections required in daily reports with appropriate US Government Representatives
